WOODCUTTER To be a woodcutter is an important occupation. Woodcutters cut down trees from which pencils can be made for writing, coloured pencils for drawing, wooden houses, a bed to sleep in, cabinets, tables, climbing frames in children playgrounds etc. Trees need to be cut down by a prescribed way so that no injuries or damage can occur. Today, woodcutters use a power saw and a range of auxiliary equipments to perform their work. They also need to protect their own health for which they use chainsaw protective leg wear and solid boots, gloves, helmet with a shield and ear protectors.
